


Key Verse

DAY - 1



Why do soldiers need armor?

To keep warm To protect
themselves from
the enemy and
his attacks

To disguise
themselves so
the enemy
wouldn't see
them coming

The armor (protection) God gives us from the enemy, is His Word the Bible.

Satan likes to tempt us to sin by lying to us and by making sin look good. When you are tempted to sin, use God's Word!

God's Word tells us that sin always brings sadness. Only loving and obeying God can bring you real happiness.

DAY - 2

James 4:7

"Therefore submit to [obey] God. Resist the devil [Satan] and he will flee from you."

This verse reminds us that it is important to:

1) Submit to God - decide to obey Him.

Remember He loves you and knows what is best.

2) Resist the devil - choose to say "no" when Satan tempts you to sin.

Remember sin will only bring you sadness.

Here are some ways you can submit to God:

- Remember what God says in His Word.
- Believe God's Word is true.
- Choose to obey God.







against Thee."




Here are some verses that can help you say no to sin. Put a check mark below the picture that each verse can help you say no to.


Ephesians 4:28 - "Let him that stole steal no more...."



Ephesians 4:29 - "Let no corrupt word proceed out of your mouth...."




Ephesians 6:1 - "Children, obey your parents in the Lord...."
