- Think about a time when you got really good news; Maybe seemed like the best news ever!
- Maybe you were told you could finally get that one thing you really wanted
- Or maybe you found out you were going to get to go on a vacation where you always wanted to go
- In this true story from the Bible we are going to learn about the best news ever!

FLASHCARD 5-1

- But remember, last week we had sad news; Jesus' followers were sad because He died and was buried in the tomb
- Do you remember why Jesus did that?

Romans 5:8 – "...God commendeth His love toward us, in that, while we were yet sinners, Christ died for us."

- It was a sad day for Jesus' followers as they watched Him die and saw His body placed in the tomb; All seemed lost

- Soldiers were in front of the tomb because the Jewish leaders commanded it
- They wanted to make sure His disciples didn't come and take the body of Jesus
- But those soldiers did not have power over that tomb like they thought; It was God Who was really in charge

FLASHCARD 5-2

- Then soldiers saw angel at the tomb, they were so afraid, Bible says they became like dead men
- When they were able to get up, ran back to the city to report to Jewish leaders what happened
- When leaders heard what happened, brought out money and said to soldiers, "Take this. Don't tell anyone what you know. Say you fell asleep and His disciples stole the body."
- The Jewish leaders did not want people to know Jesus had come back to life; They didn't want people to believe He was God; That was a terrible sin!

FLASHCARD 5-3

- Meanwhile, some women (friends of Jesus) wanted to visit the tomb; Had to wait until the 3rd day after Jesus died because of Sabbath (when they were commanded by God to rest)
- Early Sunday morning, these women were on their way to the tomb; It was still dark; Were sad Jesus was dead
- Women thought, "How will we get to His body? Who will roll the stone away for us?"
- When they came within sight of the tomb, they saw it was open; The stone was rolled back!
- One of women, Mary Magdalene, hurried to look inside, "He's gone! He's not there!"
- She hurried to find Jesus' disciples, Peter & John to see if they knew anything about it
- When she found Peter & John, she called, "They have taken the Lord out of the grave; We don't know where they laid Him."
- They immediately started for the tomb

- The other women got to the tomb before Mary Magdalene

FLASHCARD 5-4

- When they arrived, saw angel
- Angel, "Don't be afraid. I know you are looking for Jesus Who was crucified. He is not here! He is risen! Come see the place where He was lying."
- The angel was saying Jesus was alive!

- The women listened to angel & went toward the entrance of the tomb for a closer look
- Then angel commanded them, "Go quickly and tell His disciples that He is risen from the dead."
- Women were sent out to tell the good news that Jesus was alive!

- Women ran to tell good news; It was so wonderful they were almost too afraid to believe it!

FLASHCARD 5-5

- In the meantime, Peter and John were on their way to tomb
- When they got there, saw the strangest thing; Linen cloths they had used to wrap Jesus'

- body in were there, but they were empty
- And cloth that had been used to cover Jesus' face was neatly folded and put off to the side
- Couldn't believe it! Could it be that Jesus was alive?
- After seeing this, Peter and John returned home
- Mary Magdalene finally arrived at the tomb & was crying; She looked inside, saw 2 angels
- Angels, "Woman, why are you weeping?"
- Mary thought someone had stolen Jesus' body so she said...
- "They have taken my Lord away, and I don't know where they have laid Him."

FLASHCARD 5-6

- As she turned around, she saw Someone behind her; He asked, "Why are you weeping? Who are you looking for?"
- Mary thought He was gardener, "Sir, if you have taken Him away, please tell me where He is."
- The Man said, "Mary." Immediately, Mary knew Who it was! It was Jesus!

- Mary knew Jesus was God the Son, but she didn't recognize Him until He said her name
- Mary cried, "Rabboni!" (which means Teacher)
- Mary Magdalene was the first person to see Jesus after He came back to life
